



# Claude Learner Persona Generator for L&D

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## Why learner personas matter for training

Effective L&D programs don't fail because of bad content. They fail because of mismatched content. Learner personas give L&D leaders a structured way to move beyond gut instinct and design training that reflects the actual people in the room: their roles, their existing skills, their gaps, and the pressures they face on the job.

When personas are grounded in real workforce data rather than assumptions, they drive better decisions about which courses to prioritize, which skill tracks to build, and how to sequence learning across a team or organization. Without them, training investments tend to converge on the average learner, which reduces training effectiveness for most learners.

## What is a Claude skill?

## What this skill does

This skill helps L&D leaders quickly generate structured learner persona cards for the data and AI roles within their organization. Given a job role, industry, known skill gaps, and any raw supporting text (such as job descriptions or competency frameworks), it produces a persona that captures learning context, motivations, barriers, and skill focus areas.

That output can feed directly into curriculum planning, vendor conversations, or internal training audits, compressing research and synthesis work that typically takes days into something actionable in minutes.

## How to install it

This skill requires a Claude Pro, Team, or Enterprise account. To add it, download the skill zip file and upload it via Settings > Skills in Claude. The skill will then be available in any new conversation.
